NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Early signs of intoxication include dilation of pupils, muscular incoordination, and muscular tremors. Toxicity following accidental ingestion of the technical product can be minimized by vomiting within one-half hour of exposure, rapidly after exposure (<15 minutes) administer repeatedly medical charcoal in a large quantity of water or ipecac.

If toxicity from exposure has progressed to cause severe vomiting, the extent of resultant fluid and electrolyte imbalance should be gauged. Appropriate supportive parental fluid replacement therapy should be given, along with other required supportive measures (such as maintenance of blood pressure levels and proper respiratory functionality) as indicated by clinical signs, symptoms, and measurements.

In severe cases, observations should continue for at least several days until clinical condition is stable and normal. Since abamectin is believed to enhance GABA activity in animals, it is probably wise to avoid drugs that enhance GABA activity (barbituates, benzodiazepines, valproic acid) in patients with potentially toxic abamectin exposure.

(1) The following uses:

- Turfgrass (including golf courses)
- Indoor areas including residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, public structures and buildings, and transportation equipment and the non-food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments
- Terrestrial outdoor areas including ornamental plants, trees (including nonbearing fruit and nut trees), shrubs, vines, flowers and groundcovers in landscapes, lawns, playgrounds, parks, athletic fields and around residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, and public structures and buildings

(2) Uses for which USEPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and

(3) Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with USEPA requirements.

This product cannot be used to formulate end-use products for use on grass grown for sale (sod farms), grass grown for seed, in nurseries or in greenhouses. In addition, this product cannot be used to formulate end-use products for use in/on any plant grown or maintained for commercial or research purposes.
