


**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Test fabric for color fastness. Contains a dilute oxidizing agent. Do not mix with vinegar or acidic cleaners. **To Sanitize Non- food contact surfaces:** For heavily soiled surfaces a pre-cleaning step is required. Apply full strength wetting thoroughly with spray, sponge, mop, or by immersion in solution. Allow surfaces to remain wet for 1 minute. Pre-cleaning Instructions: To remove heavy soil by cleaning, spray VITAL OXIDE straight onto soils, scrub and wipe clean with a dry paper towel, cloth, or mop. **AREAS OF USE INCLUDE:** homes, vehicles, schools & daycare, gyms & locker rooms, restaurants, public transportation. **ITEMS INCLUDE:** handles, faucets, stovetops, toilet seats, tubs, toys etc. **SURFACES INCLUDE:** hard non-porous surfaces such as glass, plastic, painted wood, laminate, chrome, stainless steel, polyurethane coated hardwood floors, glazed ceramic tile, sealed concrete & linoleum floors. **To Sanitize Hard Nonporous Food Contact Surfaces:** *Staphylococcus aureus* (ATCC 6538) and *Escherichia coli* (ATCC11229) 99.999% kill. **ITEMS INCLUDE:** food processing equipment, tables, countertops, lunch boxes, highchairs, pet bowls, glassware, utensils, cookware, and dishware.
