Application to Turfgrass

LADA 0.5 G TURF & ORNAMENTAL Insecticide can be used for the control of the following listed soil inhabiting pests of turfgrass: Northern & Southern masked chafers, *Cyclocephala borealis*, *C. immaculata*, and/or *C. lurida*; Asiatic garden beetle, *Maladera castanea*; European chafer, *Rhizotroqus majalis*; Green June beetle, *Cotinis nitida*; May or June beetles, *Phyllophaga* spp.; Japanese beetle, *Popillia japonica*; Oriental beetle, *Anomala orientalis*; Billbugs, *Spherophorus* spp.; Annual bluegrass weevil, *Hyperodes* spp.; Black turfgrass ataenius, *Ataenius spretulus*; *Aphodius* spp; European Crane Fly *Tipula paludosa*; and Mole crickets, *Scapteriscus* spp. LADA 0.5 G TURF & ORNAMENTAL Insecticide can also be used for the suppression of cutworms and chinchbugs in turfgrass areas. Use LADA 0.5 G TURF & ORNAMENTAL Insecticide as directed in sites such as home lawns, business and office complexes, shopping complexes, multi-family residential complexes, golf courses, airports, cemeteries, parks, playgrounds, and athletic fields.

The active ingredient in LADA 0.5 G TURF & ORNAMENTAL Insecticide has sufficient residual activity so that applications can be made preceding the egg laying activity of the target pests. High levels of control can be achieved when applications are made preceding or during the egg laying period. The need for an application can be based on historical monitoring of the site, previous records or experiences, current season adult trapping or other methods. Optimum control will be achieved when applications are made prior to egg hatch of the target pest, followed by sufficient irrigation or rainfall to move the active ingredient through the thatch. Do not make applications when turfgrass areas are waterlogged or the soil is saturated with water. Adequate distribution of the active ingredient cannot be achieved when these conditions exist. The treated turf must be in such a condition that the rainfall or irrigation will penetrate vertically in the soil profile.

RESTRICTIONS:

Application to Ornamentals

Apply LADA 0.5 G TURF & ORNAMENTAL Insecticide as a broadcast application on ornamentals in commercial and residential landscapes. LADA 0.5 G TURF & ORNAMENTAL is a systemic product and will be translocated upward within the plant system. Optimum control will be achieved when applications are followed by sufficient mechanical incorporation, irrigation or rainfall to move the active ingredient into the soil. Make applications prior to anticipated pest infestation to achieve optimum levels of control.

Note: LADA 0.5 G TURF & ORNAMENTAL Insecticide can be used on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being grown in interior plantscapes, ornamental gardens or parks, or on golf courses or lawns and grounds.
