Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE), and restricted entry interval. Replacement Instructions

1. Introduction

Netafim's Techfilter serves the purpose of protecting the drip irrigation system.

- 2. Triflurex is the EPA registered pesticide used in the Techfilter. The active ingredient is Trifluralin. When water passes through the Techfilter, Trifluralin is released into the drip irrigation system to protect it. The operation of this technology provides very precise and even distribution of Trifluralin.

IMPORTANT: No other uses or claims are made for the use of this product beyond the protection of the drip irrigation system.

- 3. Replacing the Techfilter cartridge

The filter must be mounted:

- So the cover can be easily disassembled
- Dirt or particle contaminants will not drop back into the filter body when removing the ring set
- Use the provided protective gloves when handling the Techfilter cartridge

IMPORTANT: Do not install the filter in direct sunlight.

- 4. Effective Use and Replacement Guideline

The Techfilter can effectively protect the drip irrigation system for 200 hours of use, but no longer than 2 years of service. Replaceable Techfilter disc cartridges come in conveniently sealed packages, which have two benefits:

- Extended shelf-life
- Allows replacement of the complete cartridge without having to touch the rings
