

- b. No type on any label can be less than 6 point. Please increase font size for wording that is smaller than 6 point.
- c. Under the *Precautionary Statement* section, include the following language: "Harmful if swallowed".
- d. Under the *First Aid* Section, include the following language: "IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not include vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person".
- e. Under the *Direction for Use* section, replace the language in the box. The language should state the following: "JYM RSA is a binary (two part) system. Before use, mix equal parts of JYM RSA Part A and Part JYM RSA Part B (EPA Reg. Number 83303-2). Apply the newly mixed solution as a spray onto hard nonporous surfaces as directed below".
- f. Delete the language under the section **DISINFECTION, DEODORIZING AND CLEANING**. Replace with the following language, as described in EPA Registration Number 80346-1: "Prior to disinfection of surfaces, spray the mixture (JYM RSA Part A and JYM RSA Part B) onto the surface and allow to penetrate, and then clean all surfaces thoroughly. To disinfect surfaces reapply the mixture and allow to remain wet for ten minutes. Let air dry. No scrubbing is necessary. The product will not leave grit".
- g. Delete the language under the section **MILDESWAT**. Replace with the following language, as described in EPA Registration Number 80346-1: "To control mold and mildew on hard, non-porous surfaces, clean the surface to be treated, then spray with the mixed solution, making sure to wet completely. Let the surface air dry. Reapply as new growth appears."

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

# DIRECTIONS FOR USE

## HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

### SURFACE CLEANING PROCEDURES

Prior to application of Jymrsa as an antimicrobial deodorizing agent, gross filth, heavy soil, blood and other bodily fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of this product. Blood and other bodily fluids should be autoclaved and disposed of according to local regulations and infectious waste disposal. Use appropriate personal protection when handling items exposed to blood and bodily fluids.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. The product is designed specifically as a general cleaner and disinfectant for use in homes, hospitals, and commercial facilities. It is formulated to disinfect hard, non-porous, inanimate environmental surfaces such as floors, walls, metal surfaces, stainless steel, porcelain, glazed ceramic tile, plastic surfaces, bathrooms, shower stalls, bathtubs, and cabinets. May be used in the kitchen on non-food contact surfaces. In addition, this product deodorizes areas that are hard to keep fresh smelling including garbage cans, basements, restrooms and areas prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

**JYMRSA is a binary (two part) system. Before use, mix equal parts of PART A and PART B. Apply the newly mixed solution as a spray onto hard nonporous surfaces as directed below.**

**DISINFECTION, DEODORIZING AND CLEANING** - Remove gross filth or heavy soil prior to application of the product. Spray area until it is covered with solution. Allow product to penetrate and remain wet for ten minutes. No scrubbing is necessary. The product will not leave grit. *let*

**BACTERICIDAL ACTIVITY** - When used as directed, *let dry* this product exhibits effective disinfectant activity against the organisms: Staphylococcus aureus including Methicillin-Resistant Staphylococcus aureus, Staphylococcus epidermidis, Salmonella choleraesuis, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Klebsiella pneumoniae, Proteus mirabilis, Vancomycin-Resistant Enterococcus faecalis, and Enterobacter aerogenes and meets the requirements for hospital use.

**MILDEWSTAT** - To control mold and mildew on hard, non-porous surfaces, spray surface to be treated by making sure to wet completely. Let air dry.

**FUNGICIDAL ACTIVITY** - This product has been demonstrated to be fungicidal against Trichophyton mentagrophytes. Use as directed on hard, non-porous surfaces.

**CONTACT TIME** - Allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE** - Store in a dry place no lower in temperature than 50 degrees F or higher than 85 degrees F.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL** - Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container with water. Plastic containers may be disposed of in a sanitary landfill, incinerated, or if allowed by local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke. For containers 1 gallon or more: Do not reuse empty container (bottle, can, and bucket). Wrap container and put in trash.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL** - Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinse is a violation of Federal Law.
