Label amendment; reduce age of puppies from 6 months to 7 weeks

Your submissions dated 6/1/2008, 8/18/2008, 11/5/2008 and 11/21/2008

The amendment referred to above is acceptable in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) section 3c(7), subject to the comments listed below:

- 1. Registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. If the Agency determines that, at any time, additional data are required to maintain in effect an existing registration, the Agency will require submission of such data.
- 2. The companion animal (puppy) safety study (MRID # 47592901) that you submitted to support this action is study is classified as minimally acceptable. Since six of the 8 puppies treated in this study were 54 to 55 days old on Study Day 0, this study does not provide adequate information for use on puppies of 7 weeks of age.
- 3. The additional data (MRID #s 47519901 and 476048010) that you submitted to upgrade the companion animal study reviewed earlier (MRID #s 47385501) has been classified as confirmatory data.
- 4. This new companion animal puppy study conjunction with the previously submitted study and additional information adequately addresses the companion animal safety study requirement for use of this product on puppies at 8 weeks of age or older. Please see enclosed review for details.
- 5. Make the label changes listed below:
 - a) Revise proposed label to change "7 weeks" to "8 weeks" everywhere it appears on the label. This appears on almost every page.

- b) On page 2, change "USE ONLY ON DOGS (7 weeks of age or older)" to "USE ONLY ON DOGS OR PUPPIES 8 WEEKS OF AGE OR OLDER".
- c) Delete the following statements:
 - Pyriproxyfen provides ovicidal, larvacidal and pupal control.
 - Kills fleas before they lay eggs.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit two (2) copies of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment bearing the revised labeling.


Attach these stickers to your wall calendar or day planner on the date you give the first dose of Product, and then place another sticker on the same date for each of the next two months.
