The Agency is therefore granting the requests to extend the two-year time-limited registration restrictions. As such, the following change is being made to the terms and conditions for the product listed above:
  - a. The two-year time-limited registration restriction has been extended. The new expiration date for the registration listed above is 09/26/2027.
3. The Agency has reviewed your request to change the terms of your registration from quarterly to annual submission of enhanced incident and sales reports using EPA's standardized templates. 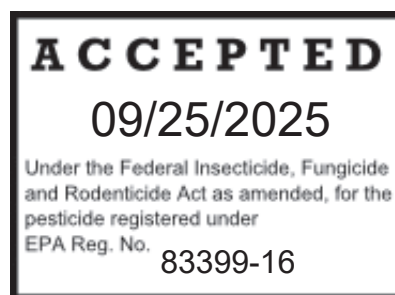

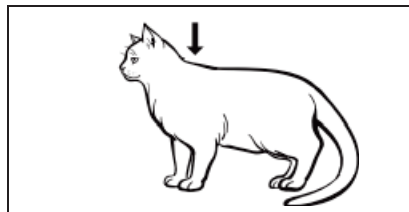

### **HOW TO APPLY:**

1. Ensure your cat is dry before applying the product and ensure your cat remains dry for 24 hours after application. The cat should be standing or in a comfortable position for easy application.
2. Part the hair down to the level of the skin, and slowly apply the product at the base of the cat's head until the applicator is completely empty. (Avoid superficial application to the cat's hair).
