



- (2) **Terrestrial non-food uses:** Golf Course Turf, Flowers, Ground Covers, House Plants, Ornamental Trees, Ornamental Shrubs, Roses, Vines
- (3) **Wood Protection:** For end use products that protect wood from wood rotting fungi and for products that protect millwork (window frames, wood doors, doorframes, etc.), in-ground wood products (pilings, telephone poles, wood building materials), and Sapstain control in fresh cut lumber.
