1. Take plant cuttings. For woody cuttings, make a 3/4 inch notch at base of cuttings.
2. Dip the base of the cuttings 3/4 inch into the RAPIDGROW® ROOTBURST POWDER (0.8%) powder. Tap off excess powder.
3. Plant the cuttings immediately in a moist growth medium. Avoid contact between the powder and foliage and other over ground parts of the stem.
4. Care for cuttings as appropriate to the plant variety.
