For resistance management, please note that **Sharda Bromacil 2% + Diuron 2% WDG** contains both a Group 5 (Bromacil) and a Group 7 (Diuron) herbicide. Any weed population may contain plants naturally resistant to Group 5 and/or Group 7 herbicides. The resistant individuals may dominate the weed population if these herbicides are used repeatedly in the same fields. Appropriate resistance-management strategies should be followed.

To delay herbicide resistance take one or more of the following steps:

- Rotate the use of **Sharda Bromacil 2% + Diuron 2% WDG** or other Group 5 or Group 7 herbicides within a growing season sequence or among growing seasons with different herbicide groups that control the same weeds in a field.
- Use tank mixtures with herbicides from a different group if such use is permitted; where information on resistance in target weed species is available, use the less resistance-prone partner at a rate that will control the target weed(s) equally as well as the more resistance-prone partner. Non-Crop Weed Control - Industrial Use Only

Sharda Bromacil 2% + Diuron 2% WDG is a non-selective granular herbicide for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. It is only for use in non-cropland areas including rights-of-way for pipeline, utility, highway, and railroad; and industrial areas including airports, petroleum tank farms, lumberyards, and plant sites. Applications of 200 - 400 lbs. of product per acre (4 - 8 lbs. bromacil/A; 4 - 8 lbs. diuron/A) per year usually result in a non-productive condition of the soil for a period of a year or more. The duration of non-productivity is dependent upon rainfall, soil type, and other conditions.

Apply **Sharda Bromacil 2% + Diuron 2% WDG** as furnished with a seed spreader, a fertilizer spreader, a shaker-type applicator, or with any equipment which will distribute the chemical uniformly over the area to be treated. For control of annual and most perennial weeds and grasses, apply **Sharda Bromacil 2% + Diuron 2% WDG** at the rate of 200 - 400 lbs. per acre (4 - 8 lbs. bromacil/A; 4 - 8 lbs. diuron/A) per year; on smaller plots, 0.5 - 0.9 lb. of **Sharda Bromacil 2% + Diuron 2% WDG** (0.01 – 0.02 lbs. bromacil; 0.01 – 0.02 lbs. diuron) per 100 square feet. Repeat spot treatment may be required when deep-rooted perennial weeds are present. To obtain best results, apply this product to the ground where it will be absorbed by the roots. Applications made early in the season have been found to give results superior as compared to applications at a later seasonal date. This product may, however, be applied at any time of the year.
