The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notifications under Pesticide Registration Notices (PRN) 98-10 and 2007-4 dated July 23, 2009 for the product Pyriithiobac-Sodium Technical (EPA Registration Number 83558-11). The Registration Division (RD) has conducted its review of this request for its applicability under PRNs 98-10 and 2007-4 and finds that the label changes requested fall within the scope of PRNs 98-10 and 2007-4. The label submitted with the application has been stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on nonrefillable containers. The code may appear either on the label (and can be added by non-notification/PR Notice 98-10) or durably marked on the container itself.
