Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this registration, the registrant shall not be permitted to use the name of the pesticide registered under this Act for any other use of the pesticide without the express written consent of the Administrator.

On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) subject to the following provisions:


1. You will submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
  - a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No. 83588-1."
  - b) This registration is limited to outerwear garments only (shirts, trousers, jackets, and the like). Tight fitting clothing items or undergarments (such as intimate apparel, bathing suits, etc.) are not permitted under this registration. Therefore, delete the term "fabric" from the Ingredient statement so it reads "Other ingredients (Garment) ..."
  - c) On the hand tag label delete the words "by a resin" in the second bullet. This was not identified in the confidential statement of formula.
  - d) Under Storage and Disposal delete "product" and "item" from the first bullet.

- 3. Since the clothing apparel will be treated with permethrin before sewn into final clothing pieces the establishment that performs the final construction of the apparel is considered a pesticide manufacturer. Such establishments must either obtain their own registrations or be under contract with the basic registrant to manufacture the final apparel pieces. You have confirmed that International Textile Group, Inc. will have contracts with clothing manufactures that will cut, sew, and label the final product under the International Textile Group, Inc. registration number. They will also obtain EPA establishment numbers. You have also confirmed that no further fabric processing other than cutting and sewing the final apparel pieces will be performed.
- 4. Please note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility document (RED) for products containing permethrin was published in the FR on June 28, 2006 (Vol 71 no. 124 pg. 36788). Additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing permethrin.
- 5. Please submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Product Chemistry data requirements for the 830 Series Subgroup A and Subgroup B guidelines are satisfied.

The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) for the basic formulation dated 01-JUN-2006 is acceptable. A copy of the CSF has been placed in the file for the subject product.
