## Dear Ms Anderson:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Delete "long lasting" from the marketing claims. Marketing claims that imply protection will extend for an indefinite period are not acceptable.
- 2. Either delete the sentence beginning, "Neither manufacturer of No Fly Zone garment nor gear...etc." or revise to read, "International Textile Group Inc. cannot guarantee complete protection from insects, insect's bites..."
- 3. The following sites of application have not been previously assessed in conjunction with fabric/garments impregnated with permethrin and must be deleted: "logos, patches, duffle bags, pouches, protective covers (unqualified), washable protective covers (unqualified), military gear (unqualified), other shelter applications (unqualified), protective and military gear (unqualified), insect screens, litters, gurneys, camping gear (unqualified) protective drapes, floor coverings (this is for dust mites), barrier materials, and protective seating."
- 4. Change "sleeping bags" to "sleeping bag covers" and "outdoor furniture fabrics" to "outdoor furniture covers". Qualify domestic animal care products by adding in parenthesis "(pet beddings, blankets)".

Please note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility document (RED) for products containing permethrin was published in the FR on June 28, 2006 (Vol 71 No. 124 pg. 36788). Additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing permethrin.

Including: sleeping bags, covers, backpacks, bed netting, long lasting, insecticide netting, tent netting, logos, patches, duffle bags, pouches, protective covers, domestic animal care products, pet bedding, blankets and washable protective covers, shoes and socks. - Wash separately from other textiles.
- DO NOT DRY CLEAN GARMENT (dry cleaning removes the Permethrin active ingredient)
- Storage and Disposal
  - Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
     Disposal: discard in trash when garment /gear is worn out.
- o Do not reuse gear for purposes other than originally intended. Neither manufacturer of No Fly Zone ™ garment nor gear nor any other insect repellent product can guarantee complete protection from insects, insect bites, or related diseases or reactions.
