**FIRST AID STATEMENT**

- **IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
- **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

(SEE BACK PANEL FOR ADDITIONAL PRECAUTIONS) Thoroughly clean out spray container with clean water. Use correct measuring device and do not mix more than is needed. To prevent foaming and ensure adequate mixing, add part of water to spray tank, then **INTERCEPTOR™**, mix and add remaining water. Agitate whilst mixing and applying.

**Application**

Ensure that all weed foliage is totally covered with spray as Interceptor is a contact spray only. Partial coverage will give partial control. With low pressure sprayers, a solid cone nozzle (1.5-2.0 L/min, 40-60psi) gives best results. This type of nozzle can be obtained from Spraying Systems Co – TG2 is recommended or equivalent spray nozzle can be used. Optimum application volumes are related to weed maturity and density and the degree of weed seed control desired. A minimum water volume of 0.20 fl. Oz. per sq ft ( 6mls per sq mtr is recommended.

Avoid prolonged contact with aluminum or rubber. Application area may become slippery when wet. Avoid area until dry.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal
