Wood Protection: AmTide Tebuconazole Technical Fungicide can be formulated into end-use Aqueous and Solvent System products to protect wood against wood-rotting fungi. It may also be formulated into end-use products used to protect:

Millwork: Window frames, wood doors, doorframes, etc.

In-Ground Contact Uses: Wood products for in-ground uses (pilings, telephone poles, wood building materials, etc.).

Sapstain Control: Fresh-cut lumber.

Restrictions:
