
Dear Ms. Kohler:

The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable provided the following conditions are met:

- 1) On page 1, revise the statement "Used exclusively for the manufacture of fungicides" to read "For Use Only in the manufacture of fungicides".
- 2) On page 1 in the ingredient statement, ensure that the percentages line up by the decimal point.
- 3) On page 2 under your "Directions for Use", delete "Use only as directed on this label".
- 4) On page 2 under your "Directions for Use", revise the last sentence of the first paragraph to read "Detailed physical and chemical proprietary information and information on formulating products containing AmTide Tebuconazole Technical Fungicide are available on request from AmTide LLC.
- 5) On page 3 of your product label, revise "Beans (succulent and dry seed) to read "Beans (fresh & dry except succulent shelled)".
- 6) On page 3 under "Wood Protection", revise the first sentence to read "AmTide Tebuconazole Technical Fungicide can be formulated into end use products that protect wood against wood rotting fungi."

Sapstain Control: Fresh-cut lumber.

This product may be used to formulate products for any additional uses not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such use.

Restrictions: Do not package end use products in metal containers.
