The product may be applied to maintain clean systems or to treat systems that are already fouled. Treatment is limited to 30 minutes once per day to maintain a residual concentration of Mexel 432/0 of 2.5 ppm.

FIRST AID STATEMENTS

Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling if available.
