The Agency has reviewed your request to amend the subject product registration which includes a request for a two year extension to the expiration date of July 29, 2012.

The amendment to extend the expiration date to July 29, 2014 is approved subject the following terms:

- 1. Submit the following data and/or information, determined by EPA to be acceptable, by the due dates specified below:

Study Type Required Data/Information	Required Data/Information	Due Date
Storage Stability (OPPTS Guideline 830.6317)	Provide the results of the ongoing two-year (minimum) storage stability study.	September 29, 2012
Corrosion Characteristics (Guideline Number 830.6320)	The corrosion characteristics study for this end-use product has been cited as ongoing. When the study has been completed and the results have been compiled, submit these data to EPA.	September 29, 2012


- 2. Adhere to the following expected environmental concentration (EEC) calculations: The pre-release calculated concentration of MBI-401 SDP must be at or below 100 parts per million (ppm) in receiving waters.

3. The agency has received the submission to address the term of registration to provide a scientific rationale with supporting information to confirm that there is not an unacceptable risk to salmonid fish species from the labeled uses of this product. These data must be found acceptable in order to extend the registration of this product beyond the expiration date of July 29, 2014.
4. As specified in the registration notice dated March 9, 2012, submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
