For Formulation into a Herbicide for selective weed control on turf and lawns, for weed control on fields prior to the planting or emergence of crops and for weed control in orchards and vineyards with non-fruit bearing trees and vines.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container at 2-8°C, in a dry, cool place out of direct sunlight and away from heat sources. Keep from overheating or freezing.
