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

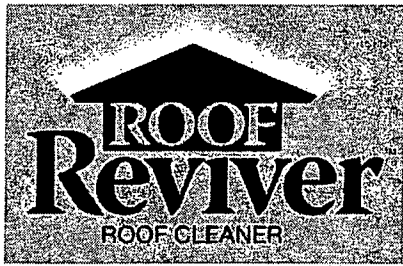

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Mixing Instructions: Fill backpack or pump-up type sprayer with 2 gal of warm water. Add 1/2 cup (for maintenance applications) up to 1 cup (for stains/moss/fungus/algae treatment) of Roof Reviver™. Mix gently until dissolved (cold water: allow 5 minutes to dissolve). Use at once. Mixed solution must not be left in an airtight container. Pressure may build up and rupture container causing serious injury.

Application Instructions: Apply to roof evenly. Rinse over-spray off of plants, gutters, painted surfaces, siding etc. Wait at least 1 hour for solution to work (product should dry). Select a removal method below:

- **Gradual Stain Removal:** Apply a second coat of Roof Reviver™ and do NOT rinse! Allow Mother Nature to rinse off over time. Results may vary with rainfall. Using this method 8lbs will treat approximately 1600 sq ft. Reapply every 60 days until stains disappear. Use annually thereafter to keep stains from reoccurring.
- *** Rapid Stain Removal:** Rinse using 400-600psi water pressure. Repeat if necessary. Note: standard garden-hose pressure (50-75 psi) will NOT work
- **Preventative Maintenance:** Apply Roof Reviver™ as directed, but do not rinse. Product will rinse off over time with adequate rainfall. You may use roof Reviver™ as a yearly maintenance program to keep stains from appearing. Application schedule will vary depending on geographical region.
- **Moss/Fungus/Green Growth Removal:** Apply Roof Reviver™ as directed but do NOT rinse. Growth will turn brown, decay and rinse off over time. Results will start within 14 days with adequate rainfall.

*Preferred treatment method

Usage and Safety Guidelines: Test on an inconspicuous area before use. For best results use when outdoor temperature is above 70°. Do not use when Temps are below 50°. Pre-wet ALL unintentional contact areas and then rinse these areas immediately upon completion. Not intended for use on metal. Use proper safety and fall protection equipment. Do not walk on roof. Roof can become very slippery! Do not mix with other chemicals. Do not use on a windy day. High pressure rinsing or scrubbing of roof material is NOT recommended. *Cistern users divert water coming off the roof by disconnecting downspouts until cleaning process is complete.

Storage and Disposal

STORAGE:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store in original, closed container in a DRY, cool well-vented location away from heat and out of direct sunlight. Keep away from combustibles and flammables.

Pesticide Disposal:

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazard. Improper disposal of excess pesticides, spray mixtures, or rinsate are a violation of federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control agency, or the hazard waste representative at the nearest EPA regional office for guidance. Triple rinse container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Container Disposal:

Non-refillable container. Do Not reuse or refill this container. Offer container for recycling, reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in sanitary landfill or by incineration or if allowed by state or local authorizes, by burning. If Burned stay out of smoke.

Precautionary Statements
