- b. Revise the "Precautionary Statements" to include the following expanded "Wash thoroughly..." statement as per the Label Review Manual. Revise to include: "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet,"
 - c. Delete the term, "recommended" from the first claim in the left column on page two such that the claim is in compliance with PR Notice 2000-5, Mandatory Labeling.
- d. Revise the "Golf Greens and Tees" direction to be incompliance with the mitigation measures outlined in the ADBAC RED by adding the statement, "Treatment is not to exceed 10 acres (2000 gallons)."
- e. Revise the "Residential Lawns/Turf" directions to be in compliance with the mitigation measures for this use outlined in the ADBAC RED by adding the statement, "Treatment is not to exceed 25 gallons per 1000 sq. feet."
- f. Revise the first statement under "Storage and Disposal" to read "Store in original container in locked storage areas in accessible to children and persons unfamiliar with its use."
- 3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

FIRST AID

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[Recommended] for use on concrete, pool surroundings, patio furniture (except cushions and wood frames), natural stone, tombstones, roofs (asphalt and fiberglass shingles, color steel, clay and concrete tiles), tennis courts, astro turf (artificial turf), ceramic pots, asphalt driveways, painted surfaces, siding (vinyl, aluminum), textured finishes, play equipment (slides, plastic gyms), wood decks, golf tees and greens, and as a spot treatment in residential lawns.

HOW IT WORKS: Once WET & FORGET has killed the moss, mold, algae and/or mildew growth, it relies on the elements to remove the stains. If the surface to be treated is not fully exposed to rainfall or is vertical, some assistance may be required to remove the stains.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO [REMOVE] [KILL] MOSS, MOLD, ALGAE, AND MILDEW: Mix 13 oz. WET & FORGET per 5 gallons of water. Apply use solution to areas infested with moss, mold, algae, or mildew with a [garden] sprayer until surface is thoroughly saturated. Let stand 10 minutes and allow to air dry. Do not employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, dried, or set. For heavy infestations, [wash off] [remove] dead moss, mold, mildew, algae 12 to 24 hours later with another application of WET & FORGET.

WET& FORGET is best applied in overcast dry conditions to avoid rapid evaporation. Do not apply if heavy rain is expected within 4 – 5 hours.

REACTION TIME: Once treated with WET & FORGET growth may take up to 6 -12 months to come clean in the worst case scenario. It is very important that the mixing instructions are followed.

MAINTENANCE: Repeat application once a year or when new growth [appears] [returns]. Do not repeat treatment more than 6 times per year.

WOOD DECKS: Follow mixing directions. Stains in Cedar or Redwood may require brushing for full stain removal. Use water and hard broom 1 month after application. Once cleaned, it may be maintained with WET & FORGET to prevent [growth] [stains].

TO REMOVE MOSS, MOLD, ALGAE, AND MILDEW STAINS: Mix 1 part WET & FORGET to 5 parts water. Apply use solution with a [garden] sprayer until surface is thoroughly saturated. Allow to air dry. A second application 1-2 months after the first may also assist when treating persistent stains. Do not repeat treatment more than 6 times per year.

PLAY EQUIPMENT: Do not allow children on play equipment (i.e., slides, plastic gyms), if it has been treated with WET & FORGET, until the equipment has been washed down with fresh water, a day after application.

PETS: Keep animals off treated surfaces until product has dried. If contamination occurs, rinse animal's paws with fresh water to prevent animal licking WET & FORGET.
