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# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**DANGER.** Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. #### **FIRST AID**

WET & FORGET EPA Reg. No. 84115-1 LABEL PER EPA Notification dated 7/13/2010 (Note to reviewer: Language in [ ] is optional or interchangeable)

For use on [sealed] concrete, [non-porous] pool surroundings, patio furniture (except cushions and wood frames), [sealed] natural stone, [sealed] tombstones, roofs (asphalt and fiberglass shingles, color steel, [sealed] clay and concrete tiles), [sealed] [non-grass] tennis courts, astro turf (artificial turf), [glazed] ceramic pots, asphalt driveways, painted [non-porous] surfaces, siding (vinyl, aluminum), [non-porous] textured finishes, play equipment (slides, plastic gyms), wood decks, golf tees and greens, and as a spot treatment in residential lawns.

**HOW IT WORKS:** Once WET & FORGET has killed the moss, mold, algae and/or mildew growth, it relies on the elements to remove the stains. If the surface to be treated is not fully exposed to rainfall or is vertical, some assistance may be required to remove the stains.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO [REMOVE] [KILL] MOSS, MOLD, ALGAE, AND MILDEW: Mix 13 oz. WET & FORGET per 5 gallons of water. Apply use solution to areas infested with moss, mold, algae, or mildew with a [pump up] [garden] sprayer until surface is thoroughly saturated. Let stand 10 minutes and allow to air dry. Do not employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, dried, or set. For heavy infestations, [wash off] [remove] dead moss, mold, mildew, algae 12 to 24 hours later with another application of WET & FORGET.

WET& FORGET is best applied in overcast dry conditions to avoid rapid evaporation. Do not apply if heavy rain is expected within 4-5 hours.

**REACTION TIME:** Once treated with WET & FORGET [growth] [stains] may take up to 6 -12 months to come clean in the [very] worst case scenario. It is very important that the mixing instructions are followed.

**MAINTENANCE:** Repeat application once a year or when new [growth] [stains] [appears] [returns]. Do not repeat treatment more than 6 times per year.

WOOD DECKS: Follow mixing directions. Stains in Cedar or Redwood may require brushing for full stain removal. Use water and hard broom 1 month after application. Once cleaned, it may be maintained with WET & FORGET to prevent [growth] [stains].

**GOLF GREENS & TEES:** Spray a solution of 1.3 oz. of WET & FORGET per 5 gallons of water until surface is thoroughly saturated. If necessary, repeat spray applications after 10 days. Treatment is not to exceed 10 acres (2,000 gallons). Do not repeat treatment more than 6 times per year.

**RESIDENTIAL LAWNS/TURF:** Use WET & FORGET as a spot treatment on areas affected by moss or algal growth/stains. Spray a solution of 5.1 oz. WET & FORGET per 5 gallons of water until surface is thoroughly saturated. If necessary, repeat spray applications after 10 days. Treatment is not to exceed 25 gallons per 1000 sq. feet. Do not repeat treatment more than 6 times per year.

TO REMOVE MOSS, MOLD, ALGAE, AND MILDEW STAINS: Mix 1 part WET & FORGET to 5 parts water. Apply use solution with a [pump up] [garden] sprayer until [dry] surface is thoroughly saturated. [Let stand 10 minutes and] Allow to air dry. A second application 1-2 months after the first may also assist when treating persistent stains. Do not repeat treatment more than 6 times per year.

**PLAY EQUIPMENT:** Do not allow children on play equipment (i.e., slides, plastic gyms), if it has been treated with WET & FORGET, until the equipment has been washed down with fresh water, a day after application.

[Metal Container:] Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.
