On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

Submit a final printed label by March 1, 2011 which makes the following changes:

- 1. Change "Active Ingredient" to "Active Ingredients", and change "Inert Ingredients" to "Other Ingredients". Add the "If swallowed" statements.
- 2. Per the Copper RED, the Chemical Abstracts Service (CAS) number for Copper carbonate must be listed in the ingredients statement "(CAS number 12069-69-1)". Additionally, the amount of metallic copper equivalent must be expressed as the percentage by weight directly below the ingredients statement "(Metallic

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copper equivalent = 0.74%)".

- 3. Relocate the signal word "CAUTION" and the statement "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" to the more prominent position above the First Aid box. Move the Net Contents, EPA establishment number and EPA registration number to the bottom of the label.
- 4. Add handler PPE below the precautionary statements as follows: "Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
  Mixers, loaders, applicators, and other handlers must wear:
  Long-sleeved shirt and long pants,
  Chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material,
  Shoes and socks."
- 5. Revise the heading "Precautionary Statement" to "Precautionary Statements" and revise the subsequent paragraph as follows: "CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals."
- 6. Per the Copper RED, add the heading "User Safety Requirements" and the following text: "Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables exist, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry."
- 7. Per the Copper RED, add the heading "User Safety Recommendations" and the following: "User Safety Recommendations: User should wash hands before, eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing. Wash the outside of gloves before removing." Place this heading and text in a box.
- 8. In the Directions for Use, revise the heading "Crops" to "Crop" and replace the paragraph with the following text: "Pears: To prevent scald. Wrap fruit within 1 week post harvest. These treated pear wraps contain a maximum of 1,000 ppm ethoxyquin. They can be used on pears that have received prior treatment with ethoxyquin providing those pears were sprayed only once with no more than 1700 ppm of ethoxyquin, or drenched only once with no more than 1,000 ppm of ethoxyquin. Do not re-use pear wraps."
  - 9. The required one year Storage Stability/Corrosion Characteristics data for

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this product are waived providing the following product expiration statement is added to each label and is updated to be always current. This is required due to data the Agency has on the active ingredient showing degradation well before one year of storage.

- "Manufacture Date (Insert date)

- \*This date is calculated 90 days from the manufacturer date shown above."
- 10. Update the Container Disposal section to comply with PR Notice 2007-4 and specify disposal for unused wraps.
- 11. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before the product is released for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A copy of the label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records.

## **CROPS**

Pears, to prevent scald. Wrap within 1 week post-harvest. One Ethoxywrap per pear. May be used on fruit which has been previously treated with Ethoxyquin pre-harvest or post-harvest. Do not re-use fruit wrap.

# Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool place. Prolonged exposure of chemical to air of sunlight may result in darkening of the product and staining of the fruit.

Pesticide Disposal: Waste resulting from use of this product must be dispose of on-site (according to label instructions), or at an approved waste disposal facility. Open dumping is prohibited. Container Disposal: Dispose of container product in a sanitary landfill or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
