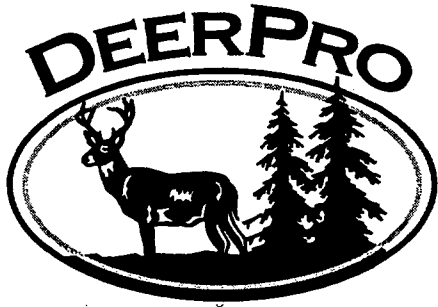

**Use Restriction: Non-food use only. Not for use on vegetables, herbs or fruit bearing plants.**

Use DeerPro™ Deer Repellent as a repellent to reduce browsing and chewing damage from deer, rabbits, and voles (*microtus* spp.). Repellency results from the odor of treated plant parts. One application will protect treated plants for 3 to 6 weeks. Treat before the expected time of animal damage.

1. Shake well before using.
2. Pump bottle 5-10 times to pressurize.
3. Press down on thumb trigger to release product.
4. Adjust stream by turning brass nozzle.
5. Thoroughly cover plant surface to be protected.
6. To permit repellent film to properly set, apply under favorable drying conditions; i.e. 30 minutes before rain or watering and relative humidity below 70% with temperature above 40°F.
7. Repeat application as needed, typically every 30 days.
8. Release bottle pressure before storing by loosening top.
