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Label Comments:

- Delete all references to Pharaoh Ants. This type of ant requires additional data. Alternatively, you may claim the following: "Ants (excluding fire, harvester, carpenter, and pharaoh ants)." If making a general ant claim, ALL references must have the text excluding fire, harvester, carpenter, and pharaoh ants.
- Delete ALL references to "Field Roach," "Shore Fleas," "March Flies," "Wind Scorpions," "Carpenter Bees," and "Waterbugs." These pests require additional data. As an alternative to "March Flies," you may claim "Cluster Flies."
- Delete the phrase "...including those resistant to certain chlorinated hydrocarbons and phosphates" as it appears on both the front panel and under the Directions for Use section.
- Under the Meat Packing and Food Processing Plants section, add the following, bolded text to the first sentence: "Use only in the inedible, non-food areas of meat packing and food-processing plants. Non-food areas include garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage areas (after canning or bottling)."
- Delete the word "General" in the heading "Precautions and Restrictions." The word general implies that the information following is advisory, not mandatory.
- Under the Precautions and Restrictions section, revise the sixth and seventh sentences as follows: "Do not contaminate food, utensils, and food preparation areas. Do not contaminate feed, food, food processing equipment, and food handling surfaces." The word "avoid" implies that the directions are advisory, not mandatory.
- Under the Active Ingredient statement, it is recommended that the common name "propoxur" be added before the chemical name.
- Under the Warranty Statement section, add the following text to the beginning of the first and last sentences: "To the extent consistent with applicable law,..."
- Move the first sentence under the User Safety Recommendations section to the Personal Protective Equipment section.
- Under the Storage and Disposal section, delete the word "Avoid," as it appears to be an incomplete sentence. Alternatively, you may complete the sentence, although it is recommended that you begin the statement with "Do not..." Avoid implies that the direction is advisory, not mandatory.

Use of Existing Stocks of Labels:
