The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 2007-4, dated May 4, 2010, for the following product:

Sungro Residual Spray, EPA Registration Number 84396-12.

The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of this request for applicability under PRN 2007-4, and finds that the label changes requested do fall within the scope of PRN 2007-4. The label has been date-stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT: Read the entire directions and conditions before using. RESIDUAL SPRAY is a highly effective formulation which provides rapid kill of the crawling insects as listed on the front panel. In addition to rapid initial kill, RESIDUAL SPRAY stays on treated surfaces and kills insects many weeks after the spray deposits have dried.

DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT IN RESIDENTIAL USE SITES, SCHOOLS, DAY CARE FACILITIES, MOTELS, HOTELS, AND OTHER AREAS WHERE CHILDREN MAY BE PRESENT.

HOW TO USE: RESIDUAL SPRAY is ready to use undiluted as it comes from the can, and must be applied with either power operated or hand pressurized sprayers. Apply as a coarse spray to surfaces until wet, moving the spray stream rapidly enough to prevent excessive wetting of surfaces and waste of material.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

COMMERCIAL / INDUSTRIAL INDOOR USE:

ANTS (excluding fire, harvester, carpenter and pharaoh ants), CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SAW-TOOTH GRAIN BEETLES (EXPOSED STAGE): Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as needed. Applications may be made to floor surfaces along baseboards and around air ducts, however, do not treat entire area of floor or floor coverings.

OUTDOOR USE:

ANTS (excluding fire, harvester, carpenter and pharaoh ants), CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, CLUSTER FLIES, GARDEN SPIDERS, SILVERFISH, MILLIPEDES, SOWBUGS: Spray thoroughly those areas where pests have been seen or found including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insects may enter. For ants, spray runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation. Do not apply as a landscape treatment (to lawns, shrubs or trees, or plants).

FOR USE IN MEAT PACKAGING & FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS: Use only in the inedible, non-food areas of meat packing and food processing plants. Remove pets and cover fish bowls or aquaria before spraying. Do not use as a space spray. Provide adequate ventilation of areas being treated. Do not spray vegetation. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber and asphalt surfaces and tiles and floor coverings. If container is leaking invert to prevent leakage. If the container is leaking or material is spilled for any reason or cause, carefully dam up spilled material to prevent runoff.
