
- b) Add the chemical name of propargite to the active ingredient statement: (Sulfurous acid, 2-[4-(1,1-dimethyl-ethyl) phenoxy] cyclohexyl-2-propynyl ester)
- c) As advised by PR Notice 94-1 you may use only one of the two statements you have added to the 'Directions for Use' section of your label to permit the reformulation of your product for a specific use or all additional uses supported by a formulator or user group. Therefore, delete:

"This product may be used to formulate products for additional uses(s) not listed on this MP label if the formulator, user group or grower has complied with U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding support of such use(s)."

- 2. You are required to generate a one year storage stability study (830.6317) for the subject product under warehouse conditions. It is recommended that observations be made at 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 months. The corrosion characteristics study (830.6320) may be conducted concurrently. An accelerated study will not substitute for a one year study under warehouse conditions.
- 3. The basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated April 13, 2008 is acceptable and is supported by a five-batch analysis. It is the basic CSF of record.
- 4. Please submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
