On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

This product is **conditionally** registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(B) subject to the following provisions:

- 1. You will submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data: and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
- 2. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
 - a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No. 84542-4."
 - b) Use of treated fabric/textiles for garments /apparel is not permitted under this registration. Therefore, delete the term "garment" from the Ingredient statement and throughout the label.
 - c) Revise the following statements as indicated:
 - This textile contains cupron anti-dustmite technology fibers.
 - This textile Treated fibers will not harbor or allow propagation of dustmites for up to ii. 4 years.
 - d) Delete "and other non-washable textile products for which anti-dustmite technology is desirable.
 - e) Revise the concentration of the active ingredient listed on the hang tag to read 4.1%.

- f) Delete "Dispose of garment in trash"
- g) Under Storage and Disposal delete "Do not reuse clothing for other purposes than as a garment".
- 3. Since the fibers/fabrics will be treated with copper before sewn into final pieces the establishment that performs the final construction of the treated articles is considered a pesticide manufacturer. Such establishments must either obtain their own registrations or be under contract with the basic registrant to manufacture the final treated articles.
- 4. One-year storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics (830.6320) data must be submitted to the Agency to fulfill the 830 Series Subgroup B data requirements.
- 5. Please submit three (2) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
