 - b. This textile Treated fibers will not harbor or allow propagation of dustmites for up to 4 years.
 - c. Delete "and other non-washable textile products for which anti-dustmite technology is desirable"
 - d. Delete "Do not reuse clothing for other purposes than as a garment"
