The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable.

The primary brand name of this product has been changed from "Yellowjacket Attractant" to "Bull Run Yellowjacket Trap." Additionally, the alternate brand names "Bull Run Yellow Jacket Attractant" and "4-Week Bull Run Yellowjacket Trap Refill" have been added to the registration, and our records have been updated accordingly. This approval does not affect any terms or conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing terms or conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release this product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR § 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR § 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to your company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). - The BULL RUN YELLOWJACKET TRAP includes the trap and the attractant.
- BULL RUN YELLOWJACKET TRAP CARTRIDGE:
 - Is the refill attractant for the BULL RUN YELLOWJACKET TRAP.
 - Contains attractant, but does not include the trap.

INITIAL SETUP

- 1. Place cotton ball into attractant cup.
- 2. Cut tip of attractant tube and carefully empty attractant liquid onto cotton.
- 3. Slide cone back into tab channels, snapping into place.
- 4. Screw bottom cap back in place.
- 5. Hang trap away from human activity, and at least 20 feet away from a known yellowjacket nest.
- 6. Wash hands with soap and water.

REUSING THE TRAP

- 1. Rebait with Bull Run Yellowjacket Trap Refill every 2 weeks.
- 2. Empty trap when rebaiting, or when dead yellowjackets accumulate above cone.
- 3. Make sure all yellowjackets are dead before emptying trap.
- 4. To increase efficiency, clean yellowjacket residue when rebaiting.

USE RATE

Use 2-4 traps for a 10,000 square foot area or 8 to 16 traps per acre. For areas with heavy infestation, use a maximum of 48 traps per acre.

CAUTION: Due to the extreme effectiveness of the attractant, use caution when placing and maintaining traps. Place and maintain traps in late evening or early morning when yellowjackets are less active. People allergic to yellowjacket stings should allow others to place and maintain traps for them. Yellowjacket stings can be fatal.

CATCHING THE QUEENS

Queen yellowjackets emerge from hibernation during the first warm days of spring to look for nest sites. When you place our traps outside at that time, you can capture these queens and reduce the likelihood that a yellowjacket nest will be established on or near your property.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated location out of reach of children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Deposit in trash for collection. Wash hands with soap and water.

This trap and included attractant only catch yellowjackets - not paper wasps. They may look similar, but yellowjackets and paper wasps have several noticeable differences: When in flight, paper wasps dangle their long legs like landing gear. Yellowjackets keep their legs tucked close to their bodies when flying. Paper wasps also have a longer, leaner, and more segmented body compared to yellowjackets. Paper wasps create open comb nests that are usually visible under eaves and other man-made structures. Yellowjacket nests have a single opening and are less visible, usually underground and in enclosed spaces.
