3. You have requested waivers for the toxicity data requirements of primary eye irritation and primary skin irritation. These waivers have been granted and toxicity category I has been assigned for each. Since you have used the cite all method of support to meet the requirement for additional product specific toxicity data, revise your labeling to be in agreement with these other products as follows:

"DANGER Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, safety glasses..."

Add the following to the "First Aid" statement:

"IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible."

- 4. Based on the proposed uses bring this label into agreement with the ADBAC Reregistration Eligibility Document RED (completed August 2006) by limiting this product to residential use only. Add the following statement to the beginning of the text on page two: "Residential Use Only."
- 5. Revise the bulleted statements at the top of page two as follows:
 - a. Delete the phrase: "Makes [insert number] gallons [5x the container size]". The Agency has revised your use rate (see item #7).
 - b. Delete the following use sites as your label does not include adequate directions for these uses. Delete "yards" and "all outdoor hard surfaces." All outdoor surfaces is too broad since specific directions are required for many sites including application to siding and roofs.
 - c. Delete the unnecessary statement: "Children and pets need not be excluded from treated areas once dry."
- 6. PR Notice 2000-5 addresses mandatory language in the directions for use section of the label. Based on this Notice revise the first section in the left column of page two to begin: "Moldbuster kills and removes mold, mildew and algae on outdoor..." In addition, delete the statement: "Moldbuster prevents early re-growth." This statement is contradictory and misleading since the product claims to kill mold there should not be any occurrences of regrowth.
- 7. The ADBAC RED limits the use of this chemical when applied to the types of outdoor surfaces listed on your label. Based on this RED and the applicable use sites on your label, reduce your rate to be in agreement with the RED at a rate no greater than 2036 ppm active ingredient. This rate is based on the Occupational & Residential Exposure Assessment. Thus delete "Mix 1 part Moldbuster to 4 parts water." Revise to read: "Mix 3.45 ounces of Moldbuster per gallon of water (2021 ppm)."

- 8. The decking use is restricted due to ecological concerns. Add the following statement: "At the maximum rate of 2021 ppm do not exceed an application rate of 25 gallons per 1000 square feet of treated area."
- 9. Add the following statement to directions for use section of the label: "Treatment limited to 6 times per year." This statement is also based on concerns raised in the ADBAD RED.
- 10. Revise the section beginning REACTION TIME. Delete the phrase: "and helps to clean the treated surfaces in the weeks and months to come." This is a residual cleaning claim which the Agency does not allow since it implies residual pesticidal kill which is misleading. In addition, the non-pesiticidal claims must be in agreement with the pesticidal claims. This product is not killing for weeks, neither is it cleaning for weeks.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
