On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

- 1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA sec 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
- 2. Make the following changes to the label:
 - a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 84708-1"
 - b. Make the following label revisions:

General Comments:

1. The provisions listed in this conditional registration are for the proposed product labeling that will be part of the retail unit package display. Separate internal labeling must also be securely affixed to each separate container in the retail unit package display. The entire packaging must be submitted for review.

Please note that the "1-800-xxx-xxxx" phone number listed in the last row of the First Aid section (table) must be substituted with a valid phone number that is available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week for answering and responding to any medical emergencies or health concerns.

<u>Directions for Use section comment(s)</u>:

- 3. Replace the 2nd sentence of this section with: "Place a small spot approximately the size of a dime on inaccessible surfaces under or behind refrigerators, stoves, sinks, tubs, dishwashers, washing machines and dryers; into openings around drains, water pipes, electrical conduits; and in cracks and crevices around baseboards, corners of cupboards, cabinets and closets."
- 3. Product chemistry data gaps were identified for storage stability and corrosion characteristics. Green Dragon Pest Solutions must generate one-year storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics (830.6320) data on the proposed product. It is required that the observations be made at 0-, 3-, 6-, 9- and 12-month intervals. The results must be submitted to the Agency in electronic and hard copy formats.
- 4. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label for the record, incorporating the above changes, before the product is released for shipment.

If the above conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Remove lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers and place into corners of drawer wells. Reapply once/30 days if needed.
