Dear Mr. Lints:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended to correct the nominal concentration of active ingredient on the label as well as update the CSFs is acceptable provided you make the following changes:

1. In the First Aid section, underline the subheading "If in eyes" to match the other subheading.
2. Delete the sentence, "Do not use impregnated wraps on fruit which have been previously treated with Ethoxyquin pre-harvest or post-harvest." This is not an EPA restriction because multiple applications of Ethoxyquin are allowed. Therefore, add the following statement, "These treated pear wraps contain 1,000 ppm ethoxyquin. They can be used on pears that have received prior treatment (spray or drench) with ethoxyquin, provided those pears were sprayed only once with no more than 1700 ppm ethoxyquin, or drenched only once with no more than 1000 ppm ethoxyquin."

The Agency now has on file the approved Basic, Alternate #1 and Alternate #2 CSFs dated 8/26/11. All previous CSFs are hereby superseded.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Crops

Pears, to prevent scald. Wrap within 1 week post-harvest, one wrap per pear. Do not use impregnated wraps on fruit which have been previously treated with Ethoxyquin pre-harvest or post-harvest. Do not re-use fruit wrap. These wraps must be removed and disposed of prior to displaying pears for sale. Do not allow consumers access to fruit wraps.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool place. Prolonged exposure of chemical to air or sunlight may result in darkening of the product and staining of the fruit. Always store pesticide in the original container.

Pesticide Disposal: Dispose of used wraps in a plastic bag, seal the bag and dispose in an on-site trash receptacle (dumpster) or at an approved waste disposal facility. Open dumping is prohibited.

Container Disposal: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse packaging. Place packaging in trash or offer for recycling if available.
