On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

The data submitted for the 14-day accelerated storage stability study at 54°C does not satisfy the 830.6317 guideline as the concentration of the active ingredient was not determined at the beginning of the test period. Also, no data regarding physical changes of the test substance as well as packaging weight change were provided. A one-year study is required to satisfy this data requirement. You have 18 months from the date of registration to provide this data.

The active ingredient, azoxystrobin, in this product can be persistent for several months or longer. Azoxystrobin has degradation products which have properties similar to chemicals which are known to leach through soil to ground water under certain conditions as a result of agricultural use. Use of this chemical in areas where soils are permeable, particularly where the water table is shallow may result in ground water contamination. This pesticide is toxic to freshwater and estuarine/marine fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority.
