

**DISINFECTION, DEODORIZING AND CLEANING**

Remove gross filth or heavy soil prior to the application of this product. Hold container 8- 12 inches from surface to be treated.

Spray area until it is covered with solution. Allow product to penetrate and the surface to remain wet for 10 minutes. Wipe off or let dry.
