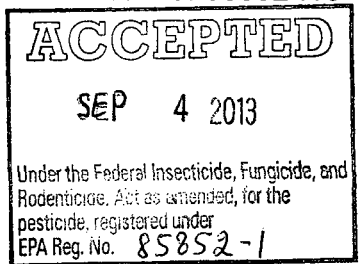

### Surface Preparation

### Application
