 This product is a light, fluffy product and therefore, the material must be added directly to the mixer. Do not add this product using elevators, long free-fall gravity chutes to minimize dust. It is critical in order to avoid loss of the low-density premix that additions be made under conditions of low air turbulence or flow (shut-off exhaust system) during this product's addition.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
