2. You submit a product specific testing efficacy data against mosquitoes for applications made to horses must be submitted no later than June 1, 2010. This study should be conducted in a manner that allows each horse to serve as a treatment and untreated control. This can be accomplished with this product since it is an aerosol formulation. Treat only one-half of each horse with product and use the untreated half as a negative control. .
3. You make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
 - a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No. 85972-1".
 - b) Remove: "Repels insects for up to 24 hours." and "Repels flies and mosquitoes for up to 24 hours."
 - c) Revise: "Apply on face by first spreading small amounts in palms of hands and spreading on face and neck." to "Apply on face by first spreading small amounts in palms of hands and spreading on face and neck, avoiding your eyes."



- d) For consistency with other registered picaridin products add: "When using on children, apply to your hands and then apply it to the child. Do not apply to their hands. To apply to a child's face and neck, apply the product into your hands and apply to the child. Take care to avoid mouth and eyes and apply sparingly around ears. Do not allow children to handle the product."
 - e) For consistency, please restrict the number of applications to the horse and rider to "two times per day".
 - f) Revise "Hazards to Humans" to read "Hazards to Humans and Horses"
4. The basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated September 23, 2009 is acceptable and is the CSF of record.
 5. Please submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

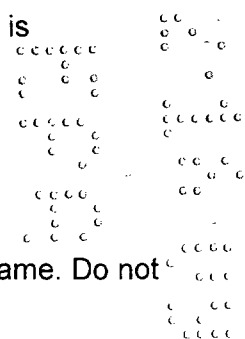

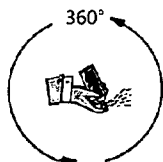

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Follow these guidelines when applying "BRAND NAME" Fly and Mosquito Repellent:



Horse and Rider:

- Hold 4-6 inches from body while spraying, keeping nozzle pointed away from face. Slightly moisten skin or hair coat with a slow sweeping motion.
- Excessive amounts or frequent reapplication is unnecessary.
- Do not spray directly on face.
- Apply on face by first spraying small amounts in palms of hands and spreading on face and neck.
- Do not apply to the hands of small children.
- Avoid contact with lips, cuts, wounds, or irritated skin.
- Do not apply to excessively sunburned skin.

Horse:

- Not for use on horses intended for human consumption.
- Reapply every 24 hours.
- Repels flies and mosquitoes for up to 24 hours.
- Do not apply under the saddle.

Rider:

- Repels insects and ticks for up to eight hours.
- Reapply every 8 hours. Do not exceed two applications per day.
- Do not apply under clothing.
- Apply sparingly around ears.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry place out of the reach of children. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Container is under pressure. Protect product container from direct sunlight and from temperatures above 122°F (50°C).

IF EMPTY: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
