

For the industrial use as a preservative for preparations for the control of bacteria, fungi and mold

ACTIVE INGREDIENT: Thymol.....	97.80%

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
