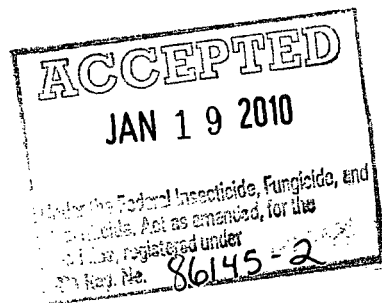

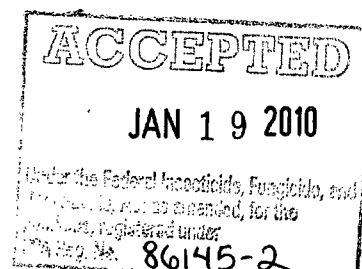

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

The presence of algae in swimming pools is objectionable and can be difficult to remove. MAGNOLIA ALGAECIDE 60% CONCENTRATED helps prevent the growth of chlorine-resistant algae, (such as mustard and "black" algae). It also acts as an added defense against algae due to low chlorination periods. Once started, algae greatly increase chlorine demand and the associated increased cost. **Freshly Filled And/Or Algae-Free Swimming Pools:** Add 8 ounces of MAGNOLIA ALGAECIDE 60% CONCENTRATED per 10,000 gallons pool water. Add 2 to 4 ounces (per 10,000 gallons) weekly as a maintenance dose to prevent algae growth through the swimming season.

Visible Algae Growth: Super-chlorinate with a fast-acting, unstabilized chlorinating product to a chlorine reading of 5 ppm. Do not use the pool until the chlorine residual has dropped to 3 ppm. Remove all debris by vacuuming or sweeping and filtering. In order to aid in the removal of the fine particles resulting from the affected algae, the use of MAGNOLIA ULTRA CLARIFIER is recommended. Add an initial dose of 16 ounces of MAGNOLIA ALGAECIDE 60% CONCENTRATED per 10,000 gallons of water to rid the water of the remaining chlorine-resistant algae. Thereafter, add 2 to 4 ounces (per 10,000 gallons) weekly during swimming season to prevent re growth of algae.



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NOTE: In order to ensure maximum effectiveness of MAGNOLIA ALGAECIDE 60% CONCENTRATED (and all other swimming pool chemicals), always maintain pH at 7.2 to 7.6 and a free-chlorine residual of 1 to 2 ppm. Measure levels by using a reliable test kit.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep product in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry well ventilated area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: IF EMPTY: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available.

IF PARTLY FILLED: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instruction. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

RESIDUE REMOVAL: Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.
