Please find enclosed the following documents on behalf of MITSUI CHEMICALS AGRO, INC. for Tachigaren Technical, EPA Reg. No. 86203-3:

- Application for Pesticide Registration (EPA Form 8570-1)
- Confidential Statement of Formula (EPA Form 8570-4).
- Five copies of draft labeling for Tachigaren Technical.

The registration of Tachigaren Technical was transferred from Sankyo Agro Co., Ltd. (herein after, Sankyo Agro), EPA Reg. No. 48210-2, to Mitsui Chemicals Agro, Inc. (herein after, MCAG), EPA Reg. No. 86203-3, on April 5, 2010. Pursuant to the transfer of the registration of Tachigaren Technical, the enclosed draft labeling and revised CSF reflects the current registrant name, address and EPA registration number. Additionally, the enclosed label has been revised to comply with the requirements of PR Notice 2007-4 and the CSF reflects the location of the Producing facility, as explained below. All changes are highlighted in yellow background with additions in normal type-face and deletions in ~~strike~~through.

The initial production of Tachigaren Technical was contracted by the original registrant, Sankyo Company, Ltd. (herein after, Sankyo Company), to an external toll manufacturer. The Producing Facility in Block 2 of the originally approved CSF for Tachigaren Technical, dated June 18, 1993, was listed as a factory of the registrant, Sankyo Company, because the toll manufacturing agreement stipulated that Sankyo Company leased the manufacturing plant from the toll manufacturer. That manufacturing plant was considered by Sankyo Company to be a branch factory of the Sankyo Company factory named on the 1993 CSF.
