Following review of the residue data submitted in support of the IR-4 petition (PP# 1E7925) EPA established etofenprox tolerances for: in or on food commodities; feed commodities; eggs; hog fat; hog meat; hog, meat byproducts; fat of cattle, goat, horse, and sheep; meat of cattle, goat, horse, and sheep; meat byproducts of cattle, goat, horse, and sheep; milk; poultry, fat; poultry, meat; and poultry, meat byproducts. 

Etofenprox is an insecticide for formulation into pesticide products intended for use in rice fields, indoor and outdoor non-food/feed areas of residential, commercial and industrial establishments, outdoors as a wide-area mosquito adulticide that may include but is not limited to applications over agricultural, pasture and rangelands. Repeated exposure to etofenprox can cause skin irritation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dark and dry area. Protect from heat.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Handling:

Metal: Nonrefillable Container. Do not use or refill this container.

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into a container for mixing. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into a container for mixing or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Then offer for recycling, if available or reconditioning, if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
