

The amendment referred to above is acceptable in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) section 3(c)(5), subject to the comments and conditions listed below:

1. Registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. If the Agency determines that, at any time, additional data are required to maintain in effect an existing registration, the Agency will require submission of such data. Dinotefuran is subject to Registration Review. EPA's review of data and other information in connection with these matters may impact your product once complete.
2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of this condition. If this condition is not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e).

Use of this chemical in areas where soils are permeable, particularly where the water table is shallow, may result in ground water contamination. Periodic monitoring of shallow ground water in the use area is recommended.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.**

Dinotefuran Technical is intended for use only in the formulation of insecticide products used in the control of sucking, biting and chewing insects and certain public health pests in the following sites:

**Terrestrial Non-food Crop, or Residential and Commercial Outdoor:** Lawns, turf, perimeters, forests, and ornamentals.

**Terrestrial Food Crop:** Cotton, leafy vegetables, fruiting vegetables, cucurbits, potatoes, grapes, head and stem brassica, leafy brassica greens (crop subgroup 5B), rice, turnip greens, and vegetable transplants.

**Residential and Commercial Indoor:** Crack and crevice, general, and spot treatment for residential areas; Area and Space sprays; Greenhouses, Ornamental (Residential and Commercial), Nursery Grown Plants and Greenhouse Tomatoes.

**Indoor Food:** Crack and crevice, general, and spot treatment for food and food handling establishments and storage areas.

**Companion Animals:** Spot on formulations for cats and dogs.
