AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR Part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, greenhouses and handlers of agricultural insecticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification and emergency assistance. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Failure to follow directions and precautions on this label may result in crop injury, poor insect control, and/or illegal residues.

Trebon 3G should only be applied through aerial application. Confine all granular applications to field areas. Cut off application equipment to avoid treating adjacent roads, field drains, ditches, banks, and other non-target areas. Apply Trebon 3G only when weather conditions are calm to prevent misplacement of granules. Avoid making application under conditions where uniform coverage cannot be obtained or where excessive drift may occur.

RICE: To control Rice Water Weevil, apply 6 to 9 lbs of Trebon 3G per acre (2.9 to 4.3 oz. a.i./A) 3 days before to 7 days after flooding. Trebon 3G should be applied only when adults are present in a field and conditions are favorable for oviposition. Do not make more than one application per season. Permanent flood waters may not be released until 7 days after application.

Pre-Harvest Interval (PHI) - Do not apply within 60 days of harvest.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

Pesticide Storage: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store diluted spray. For help with any spill, leak, fire or exposure involving this material, call day or night 1-800-CLEANUP.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Handling

Plastic Container: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

Triple rinse (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or if allowed by State and Local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Lined Paper Bag: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then offer for recycling if available or dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
