- 2. You must submit the following conditional data before the due date of February 1, 2011:
 - a. Storage Stability (830.6317) and Corrosion Characteristics (830.6320) studies.
- 3. You must submit or cite the following conditional data before the due date of December 2011:
 - a. Barley field trial data from regions 9 and 10 (along with concurrent storage stability data on barley straw).
 - b. One additional field trial for mustard greens conducted in Zone 3.
- 4. Make the following changes to the label:
 - a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 86296-1"
 - b. On page 2 under the header HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS change the text to read: "May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust. Wear a dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C) or a NIOSH approved respirator with any N, R, P, or HE filter. Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."
 - c. On page 2 under **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS** add the following:
 - "Ground Water Advisory: Tebuconazole is known to leach through soil into ground under certain conditions as a result of label use. Use of this chemical in areas where soils are permeable, particularly where the water table is shallow, may result in ground-water contamination.
 - **Surface Water Advisory:** This product may contaminate water through drift of spray in wind. This product has a high potential for runoff for several months or more after application. Poorly draining soils and soils with shallow water tables are more prone to runoff that contains this product. A level, well maintained vegetative buffer strip between areas to which this product is applied and surface water features such as ponds, streams, and springs will reduce the potential for contamination of water from rainfall-runoff. Runoff of this product will be reduced by avoiding applications when rainfall is forecasted within 48 hours."
 - d. On page 2 under **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR USE** change "...formulated using Tebuconazole..." to "...formulated using TrustChem Tebuconazole Technical Fungicide...."

- e. On page 2 make the following changes to the Terrestrial food/feed crops: table
 - i. Change "Corn/Corn (seed treatment)" to "Corn (sweet, field, seed and popcorn)"
 - ii. Change "Garden Beets" to "Garden Beets (root and tops)"
 - iii. Delete "Green Eschalots"
 - iv. Change "Leafy Brassica Greens" to "Brassica Leafy Greens (subgroup 5b)"
 - v. Change "Shallot" to "Shallot (dry)"
 - vi. Change "Turnip" to "Turnip (East of the Rockies)"
- f. On page 3 put the **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** instructions into a box to set them off from the rest of the text.
- g. On page 3under the header **WARRANTY LIMITATIONS AND DISCLAIMER** make the following changes:
 - i. In line 3 change "...to the extent allowed by state law..." to "...to the extent consistent with applicable laws..."
 - ii. In line 5 delete the word "abnormal".
- 5. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before the product is released for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
