The changes identified below must be made to the proposed label marked "SS-5212 9/09" that was part of the submission of December 16, 2009, for this product.

- 1. In the statement of ingredients, footnote "Mineral Oil" (in the "ACTIVE INGREDIENT:" line) with the phrase "Contains petroleum distillates".
- 2. Change the order of treatments listed under "FIRST AID" to:

If on skin or clothing: ...
If swallowed: ...

If in eyes: ...

If inhaled: ...

- 3. In the first sentence of the "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN", change "mineral oil" to "petroleum distillates".
- 4. Replace the paragraph directly below "<u>PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS</u> Hazards to humans and domestic animals." with the text shown below.

CAUTION:

Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

- 5. Revise the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section as indicated below.
 - a. Delete the numbers that precede the subheadings.
 - b. Delete the subheading "**Prohibitions**:" but retain the text that immediately follows it ("Do not contaminate water ... is prohibited").
 - c. Change the subheading "Storage:" to "Pesticide Storage:".
 - d. Revise the "Container Disposal:" paragraph to include appropriate text pertaining to: (1) whether containers are refillable, (2) rinsing containers, and (3) recycling containers. See PR Notice 2007-4, as revised on April 29, 2008, and 40 CFR §156 Subpart H.
- 6. Make the changes indicated below to the "**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**" section.
 - a. In the second paragraph, replace "Only for formulation into the end use products for the following:" with "This product is registered for formulation into end-use products for the following uses:".
 - b. In the last paragraph ["This product may be ... use(s)"], insert "also" between "product" and "may be".

7. In the "LIMITED WARRANTY & LIABILITY" section, insert "TO THE EXTENT CONSISTENT WITH APPLICABLE LAWS," as an introductory phrase to the following sentences: "MANUFACTURER AND SELLER DISCLAIM ...
