- 4. Submit storage stability and corrosion characteristics (Guidelines 830.6317 and 830.6320) data as these data requirements are not satisfied. A one-year study is required to satisfy these data requirements. You have 18 months from the date of this registration to provide these data to the EPA.
- 5. If, following consultation with the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, the Service identifies additional mitigation measures are necessary to prevent adverse effects to any listed species or their designated critical habitat, EPA will notify registrants in writing within 45 calendar days of completion of any such consultation of any necessary required changes.
