Repeated overexposures can result in blurred vision, staggering gait and mental imbalance, with probable recovery after a period of no exposure. Blood bromide levels suggest the occurrence, but not the degree, of exposure. Treatment is symptomatic.

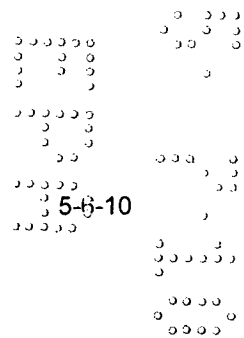
Extremely hazardous liquid and vapor under pressure. Do not breathe vapor. Inhalation may be fatal or cause serious acute illness or delayed lung or nervous system injury. Liquid or vapor can cause serious skin or eye injury which may have a delayed onset. Do not get liquid on skin, in eyes or on clothing.

Methyl bromide vapor is odorless and nonirritating to skin and eyes during exposure. Exposure to toxic levels may occur without warning or detection by user.

Methyl bromide is heavier than air and may be trapped inside clothing and cause skin injury. If liquid spills or splashes on clothing, shoes or socks, remove them immediately. Do not reuse contaminated clothing or shoes until thoroughly aerated or ventilated and cleaned. Discard clothing and shoes that have been heavily drenched or contaminated with this product.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

- Wear loose-fitting or well ventilated long-sleeved shirt and long pants, shoes and socks.
- Full-face shield or safety glasses with brow and temple shields (DO NOT WEAR GOGGLES) when handling liquid product.
- A respirator is required if the acceptable air concentration level of methyl bromide in the working area, as measured by a direct-reading detector device (e.g. Draeger hand pump and detector tube, etc.) exceeds 5 ppm (20 mg/m3). The respirator must be one of the following types:
 - a supplied-air respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approved number prefix TC-19C) OR
 - a self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-13F).
- Do not wear jewelry, gloves or boots when handling.



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ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. In fires fueled by other materials, methyl bromide may liberate hazardous gases. The use of methyl bromide with aluminum, magnesium, zinc and alkali metals will result in the liberation of toxic gases, and possible fire and explosion. In addition, severe corrosion of containers and equipment made of these metals will occur.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Methyl Bromide may be used only for repackaging or formulating into an economic poison end-use product intended for Terrestrial, Greenhouse, Domestic Outdoor, and Indoor Food and Non-Food Uses. Registration by the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency is required before the new product can be lawfully distributed in interstate commerce.

Methyl bromide is a highly hazardous material and must be used only by individuals trained in its proper use. All persons working with methyl bromide must be knowledgeable about the hazards, and trained in the use of required respirator equipment and detector devices, emergency procedures, and proper use of the fumigant.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminated water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a dry, cool, well-ventilated area under lock and key. Post as a pesticide storage area. Do not contaminated water, food, or feed by storage. Store cylinders upright, secured to a rack or wall to prevent tipping. Cylinders should not be subject to rough handling or mechanical shock such as dropping, bumping, dragging, or sliding. Do not use rope slings, hooks, tongs or similar devices to unload cylinders. Transport cylinders using hand truck, fork truck or other devices to which the cylinder can be firmly secured. Do not remove valve protection bonnet and safety cap until immediately before use. Replace safety cap and valve protection bonnet when cylinder is not in use.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide is a violation of Federal law. Do not permit entry into the spill or leak area by any other person until the air concentration level of methyl bromide is measured to be less than 5 ppm.

Contaminated soil, water, and other cleanup debris is a toxic hazardous waste. Report spill to the National Response Center (800-424-8802) if the reportable quantity of 1000 pounds is exceeded.
