House Mice: Apply 1 bait bag per placement, usually spaced 8 to 12 feet apart. Two bags may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain a constant supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

Follow-up: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Wearing waterproof gloves, collect and properly dispose of dead animals and leftover bait and bait bags, as well as any bait that has become accessible to non-target animals.
