d Delete 2nd "Pesticide Disposal" statement on page 2

e Revise the subheading "Container Disposal" to read "Container *Handling*"

f According to the Container Rule and PR Notice 2007-4, the label must provide container rinsate instructions based on the size of the container. These instructions were misplaced in the "Pesticide Disposal" instructions. Revise the "Container Handling" section by adding the following sections

For containers > 50 pounds Triple rinse as follows Empty remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank Fill the container 1/4 full with water Replace and tighten closures Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds Stand container on its end and tip it back and forth several times Turn container over on its other end and tip it back and forth several times Empty rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip Repeat procedure two more times

For containers ≤ 50 pounds Triple rinse as follows Empty remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap Shake for 10 seconds Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip Repeat procedure two more times


